Thanks to the generous support of our sponsor, Afforda, we are excited to offer a hands-on tour and service project with **Mountainlands Community Housing Trust** on **Monday, August 31,** the **opening day of the Utah Housing Matters Conference.**

The bus will load at 7:40 a.m. at the Zermatt Utah Resort & Spa in Midway. Led by Jason Glidden, Executive Director of Mountainlands Community Housing Trust, participants will visit several Mountainlands communities and learn how the organization uses the community land trust model to expand affordable housing opportunities throughout Summit and Wasatch counties.

The tour will highlight a wide range of innovative housing solutions, including newly developed Low-Income Housing Tax Credit apartments, non-LIHTC affordable rentals, deed-restricted ownership condominiums, and deed-restricted single-family homes. Participants will also have time to enjoy lunch and explore downtown Park City before traveling to Parkview Place for the service portion of the day.

At Parkview Place, a growing community of deed-restricted single-family homes, townhomes, and duplexes, participants will help complete the neighborhood's community garden. This service project offers a meaningful opportunity to support Mountainlands' work while contributing directly to a community that will serve Utah families for years to come.

The bus will return to Zermatt in time for the 3:30 p.m. State Housing Update and Legislative Panel and opening reception. If you are a hands-on learner, interested in community land trusts, inspired by creative affordable housing solutions, or eager to support an organization making a lasting difference in Utah communities, this tour is for you.

The service project will involve gardening, so please wear comfortable clothing and shoes that you do not mind getting dirty.
